

OWATONNA (October 9, 2007) – Sarah Heineman had 12 kills and three blocks to lead a balanced offensive attack as the North Iowa Area Community College volleyball team beat Pillsbury Baptist College 30-18, 30-13, 30-21 on Tuesday night in non-conference play.

Kallie Winn was 14 of 15 serving with one ace and added 24 assists and seven digs for the Trojans (7-14). Anita Whitehead produced 11 kills and five digs to help her team's defensive effort and Lindsey Urbatsch (St. Ansgar/HS) had nine kills as head coach Ted Bieth's team dominated play throughout. Nicki Sandberg was 14 for 17 serving with three aces. Brittany Johnston was 11 of 12 serving with an ace and had six digs.

NIACC opened strongly in game one as Urbatsch had four kills. Game two was dominated by the Trojans, who took an early 12-2 edge and coasted from there. Heineman led her team with four kills in that game. In game three, Whitehead took control, producing seven kills as the Trojans pulled away after Pillsbury stayed close until the midway point of the game.

On Saturday, NIACC plays in a quadrangular tournament at Ellsworth Community College, with play beginning at 9 a.m. in Iowa Falls.
